 - A. Nation in moral decline.
 - B. Lost our enthusiasm for God.
 - C. We have lost sight of the vision.
 - 1. Left our first love.
 - 2. Contend for the faith once delivered unto the saints.

- II. ACTS 4:29:37 - LORD, BEHOLD THEIR THREATENINGS
 - A. Grant thy servants boldness to speak thy word (did not ask to change them).
 - 1. By stretching forth thy hand to heal.
 - 2. That signs and wonders may be done by the name of thy holy child Jesus.
 - B. When they prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together.
 - 1. They were filled with the Holy Ghost.
 - 2. Spoke word with boldness (their prayer fulfilled)
 - 3. Multitude of them that believed were of one heart.
 - 4. With great power gave witness of the resurrection of Jesus.
 - 5. Great grace was upon them all (blessings of God rested upon them)

- III. WHAT IS REVIVAL?
 - A. Webster - A bringing or coming back into use, attention, or being, after a decline. A restoration to vigor or activity. A stirring up of religious faith among those who have been indifferent, usually by fervid evangelistic preaching at public meetings, characterized by public confession of sins, professions of renewed faith, etc.
 - B. Vine's (revive) - To flourish anew. To live again, to regain life. To spring back into activity.
