

IT IS GOD'S WILL TO HEAL YOU

I. IF IT BE THY WILL.

- A. (Luke 5:12 KJV) And it came to pass, when he was in a certain city, behold a man full of leprosy: who seeing Jesus fell on his face, and besought him, saying, Lord, if thou wilt, thou canst make me clean.
- B. (Luke 5:13 KJV) And he put forth his hand, and touched him, saying, I will: be thou clean. And immediately the leprosy departed from him.

II. WILL OF GOD TO HEAL IN OT.

- A. (Exo 15:26 KJV) And said, If thou wilt diligently hearken to the voice of the LORD thy God, and wilt do that which is right in his sight, and wilt give ear to his commandments, and keep all his statutes, I will put none of these diseases upon thee, which I have brought upon the Egyptians: for I am the LORD that healeth thee.

III. WILL OF GOD IN NEW TESTAMENT.

- A. (Acts 10:38 KJV) How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.
- B. (James 5:14 KJV) Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord: (James 5:15 KJV) And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him. (James 5:16 KJV) Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much.
- C. Commission to 12, 70, church, believers.
 - 1. (Mat 10:5 KJV) These twelve Jesus sent forth, and commanded them, saying, Go not into the way of the Gentiles, and into any city of the Samaritans enter ye not: (Mat 10:6 KJV) But go rather to the lost sheep of the house of Israel. (Mat 10:7 KJV) And as ye go, preach, saying, The kingdom of heaven is at hand. (Mat 10:8 KJV) Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out devils: freely ye have received, freely give.
 - 2. (Luke 10:8 KJV) And into whatsoever city ye enter, and they receive you, eat such things as are set before you: (Luke 10:9 KJV) And heal the sick that are therein, and say unto them, The kingdom of God is come nigh unto you.
 - 3. (Mark 16:17 KJV) And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my

name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; (Mark 16:18 KJV) They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.

- A. Mat 8. Healed all.

- B. (Mat 9:35 KJV) And Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people.
- C. (Mat 12:5 KJV) Or have ye not read in the law, how that on the sabbath days the priests in the temple profane the sabbath, and are blameless?
- D. (Mat 14:34 KJV) And when they were gone over, they came into the land of Gennesaret. (Mat 14:35 KJV) And when the men of that place had knowledge of him, they sent out into all that country round about, and brought unto him all that were diseased; (Mat 14:36 KJV) And besought him that they might only touch the hem of his garment: and as many as touched were made perfectly whole.
- E. (Luke 16:19 KJV) There was a certain rich man, which was clothed in purple and fine linen, and fared sumptuously every day:
- F. (Luke 4:40 KJV) Now when the sun was setting, all they that had any sick with divers diseases brought them unto him; and he laid his hands on every one of them, and healed them.

XI. PRAY WHOLE SPIRIT, SOUL, BODY BE PRESERVED BLAMELESS.(1 Th 5:23 KJV) And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and I pray God your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.
